RLA performed an assessment update to a 2008 survey of 18 sculptures and new condition reports for newly added artworks. Prioritization of treatments has led to a design plan for conservation involving regular maintenance and addressing damage as it comes up. Treatments have included: conservation of a contemporary wood sculpture, ongoing care of a site-specific Yayoi Kusama installation, repainting of two large works, conserving a mosaic-clad specific column and dealing with the issues of public interaction with sculptures. We perform maintenance on a regular basis for the permanent collection.</p> |
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
